We work to embed throughout our operations a robust risk management framework to ensure we effectively analyse and manage the risks to our business. This includes analysing the risk of inadvertently working with suppliers who do not share our commitment to anti-slavery and human trafficking.

Supplier due diligence: As suppliers are partners in our business success, they are expected to comply with all local laws and regulations. We reserve the right to request information concerning, amongst other things, health & safety, environmental, equality, anti-corruption and insurance protection to enable us to verify their commitment to Central Supplies Limited corporate values and company policies.

Whistleblowing: We encourage employees and suppliers to report in good faith any issues or concerns about potential violation of human rights, legal or regulatory requirements, and improper or unethical business practices such as fraud or bribery involving our company or our employees. We maintain a whistle-blower system, that allows for anonymous reporting of any such improper behaviour. This system is proactively advertised throughout the company on notice boards and walls.
